

SAFETY SUGGESTIONS

Don't bathe the baby close to a stove or heater where they might receive a burn.

Don't put hot water into the tub while the baby is in it.

Never leave the baby alone in the tub, on the changing table, or any place where they might roll over and fall (*like your bed!*).

Never leave plastic bags or wrapping where your baby can reach them.

Install smoke detectors in proper places throughout your home.

Don't attach pacifiers, medallions, or other objects to the crib or body with a cord.

Turn the thermostat on the water heater **below** 120°. If the hot water faucet should be turned on accidentally the water will not scald the baby.

Remember to use an approved car seat at **ALL** times, starting with your infant's first car trip from the hospital to home. It's not only a matter of safety; it's the **LAW!**
